

How to Give Insulin Injections

INSULIN PENS:

- 1. Remove cap from pen. Clean rubber part with alcohol wipe
- 2. Remove paper cover from pen needle and screw onto pen until tight
- Pull off outer and inner needle shield (keep outer for later)
- 4. Prime the pen by turning dose knob to 2 units and pushing the dose knob in until it resets to "0" and insulin appears at the tip of the needle
- 5. Dial the pen to the number of units desired for the injection (the number should line up with the notch in the dose window
- 6. Choose an injection site, clean with an alcohol wipe and let air dry
- 7. Pinch a 1-2 inch area of skin and fat between your thumb and first finger
- 8. Insert the needle into the site at a 90 degree angle. Push the dose knob all the way in until it resets to "0" to deliver the insulin. Leave in place for 5 seconds
- 9. Remove the needle from the site at the same angle it was inserted
- 10. Carefully place outer needle shield back on needle and twist to remove needle from pen
- 11. Replace pen needle cap. Store at room temperature. Expires 28 days after opening
